GFL will collect up to 10 properly prepared bags and/or bundles of residentially generated yard waste also on Fridays. Limbs/branches cannot be larger than 18 inches in dia., 4' in length and must be tied in a bundle. Must be 40#'s or less.

Must be placed in biodegradable paper bags; or bundled and placed at the curb. Plastic bags, wood fencing, landscape timbers, flowerpots, yard décor, mulch, rock, dirt and similar items will not be accepted.
