GFL WASTE P/U: am on Friday's,

10 properly prepared bags generated yard waste. Limbs/branches cannot be larger than 18 inches in dia., 4' in length and must be tied in a bundle. Must be 40#'s or less and in biodegradable paper bags; or bundled and placed at the curb.

TRASH CONTAINERS: Again, containers are being left out!

Trash containers go in a storage location or garage. Clear from the view of any other homeowner or common area. They can only be visible on Thursday and stored Friday after pick up.

27th Annual Household Hazardous Waste; Mark your calendars: this year's event is May 4th for Independence residents:

Collection event will take place from 9AM-1 PM on Saturday, May 4th in the large parking lot bordered by Walnut, Liberty, Kansas and Osage St.

Free for Independence residents, driver's license or recent utility bill is required to verify residency.

Products that will be accepted include:

• Batteries, paint and paint products (including aerosol cans), varnish, stripper, turpentine, fluorescent light bulbs, garden, yard products (herbicides, pesticides, weed killer, rat poison), automotive fluids (antifreeze, used motor oil), household cleaners (drain, toilet, oven), kerosene, mercury thermometers and used medicine.

• Independence Police will also collect unwanted firearms, ammunition, fireworks and other explosive items.
