No boats, trailers or storage vehicles are allowed on any part of any lot or parked at curb for more than 24 hours.

Boats, Campers, Trailers,
Recreational Vehicles,
Inoperable or Derelict Vehicles,
Motor Homes and Other Vehicles
too Large for Storage in the
Owner's Garage:

No boats, campers, trailers, recreational vehicles, commercial vehicles, trucks, wreckers, inoperable or derelict vehicles, motor homes, boat trailers and trailers of any other description shall be permitted to be parked or stored on any Lot unless they are parked or stored in the owners enclosed garage
